RYUKOJI-TEMPLE

Ryukoji-temple is called "Oinarisan of Mima" the local district. Everyone has friendly feelings towards it. It has a gateway to a Shinto Shrine. Stone images of guardian dogs welcome people to this shrine. Images of stone foxes and little human faces "jizo" are also erected side by side. It is a rare temple with a mixture of Shinto images.

Seibei Yanbe served the eldest son Hidemune of Masamune Date, a famous feudal lord in the 17th century. However, Hidemune disliked Seibei and killed him and his entire family. After that the Warei Shrine was founded to prevent Seibei's curse.



THE GATEWAY TO WAREI-SHRINE

The gateway to this Shinto Shrine is made of stone and it is the highest gateway to a shrine in Japan. It was built in 1938 and is 12 meters tall.
